

COMIX35 Privacy Policy [updated 25 May 2018]

ROX35 Media Inc. d/b/a COMIX35, a New Mexico nonprofit ministry corporation currently operating as a registered foreign nonprofit corporation in Texas (referenced hereafter as "COMIX35", "we," "us," and/or "our") respects the privacy of visitors to our ministry informational websites located at http://www.comix35.org/comix35_home.html and http://www.christiancomicsinternational.org/ci_home.html and our social media websites at <http://twitter.com/nbutlercomix35> and <http://www.facebook.com/COMIX35.CCI> (referenced hereafter as "our Websites") and is committed to the careful handling your Personal Information (referenced hereafter as "Personal Information," and generally referring to all data that directly or indirectly relates to you, but "personal information," "personal data," or "personally identifiable information" and other terms may apply based upon applicable law, and "Personal Information" will carry the meaning of those applicable laws).

We encourage you to read this complete, updated COMIX35 Privacy Policy (referenced hereafter as "our Policy") carefully so that you understand what information we collect through our Websites, what we do with that information, and to know your rights as a partner with COMIX35. Continued use of our Websites and/or mobile applications, and continuing as a subscriber to our e-mail list, on or after 25 May 2018, constitutes an acknowledgement and acceptance of this updated version of our Policy.

You may have accessed COMIX35 directly by visiting our Websites or through the website of a third-party business or ministry associated with COMIX35. This notice applies to all information you submit to COMIX35 through our Websites. Please note that we cannot be responsible for the information you submit either via and/or directly to third parties who may have their own, posted policies regarding the collection and use of your information. We urge you to review the policies of the related businesses listed at the end of this Privacy Policy through whom you may have accessed our ministry.

If you are located in the European Economic Area (referenced hereafter as "EEA") or the United Kingdom, you have certain rights related to your Personal Information. If you wish to exercise any of these rights, please e-mail COMIX35 at privacy@comix35.org. We will respond to your request within 30 days of accepting it. We may need to verify your identity by asking for some identity documentation from you in order to process your request and to make sure we don't inadvertently provide your Personal Information to someone else.

Our Policy applies only to information collected online through our Websites and does not describe the ways in which we may collect or use information obtained offline or through any means other than our Websites.

The Web is an evolving medium. We reserve the right to change our Policy as necessary, so we encourage you to review it periodically. Any changes or updates will be posted here on the COMIX35 Policies page.

Our Current Policy Update

COMIX35 has always sought to keep our Policy as short, simple, transparent, and easy to understand as possible regarding the information we collect and why, and our core commitment regarding your privacy has not changed. However, the global nature of the Internet means that the General Data Protection Regulations (referenced hereafter as "GDPR"), established to protect user privacy in the European Union, now affects everyone operating online. As part of our continued commitment to privacy and transparency, we have updated our Policy, effective 25 May 2018, to address these new data privacy laws, which we expect will become the basis for an international standard in time.

Our Commitment To Privacy

COMIX35 has always been committed to the protection of your Personal Information entrusted to us while we have labored together with you to fulfill our mission to bring people to Jesus Christ through the visual storytelling medium of comics. (For example, COMIX35 has had a formal policy in place since January 1998 restricting the sharing of any individual's contact information without the contact's written permission.)

The purpose of our Policy is to explain to you how COMIX35 might use your Personal Information and how seriously COMIX35 takes its obligation to you to protect your rights and your Personal Information.

Collection & Use Information

The information COMIX35 may collect, process, and use falls into two categories:

- (1) **User-submitted/Personal Interaction/Subscription Information:** (a) Voluntarily supplied Personal Information provided on our Websites, such as your contact details including e-mail address, postal address, telephone number and instant messaging details, may be gathered to identify you and send you notifications and newsletters related to our ministry; (b) Your name and contact details may have been referred to us by someone you know, who indicated that you might be interested in hearing about our ministry; (c) COMIX35 also may collect user-submitted location information such as postal addresses when you voluntarily supply this information to register for events and activities, to order materials, or to make donations via our Websites or by e-mail, and

- (2) **Browser Level Information and IP Addresses:** Statistical information gathered by Google Analytics on usage patterns and preferences as visitors navigate through our Websites. The usage information we collect from you will be used to (a) monitor the operation, technical functions and quality of our Websites, (b) compile general statistics regarding use of our Websites, and (c) analyze demographic information about our Websites users. We may also use such information for research or improvements of the Site and the services we offer you. Please note that your browsing of our Websites is completely anonymous. No attempt is ever made by COMIX35 to determine the identity or tastes of individual visitors. We are primarily interested in what countries visitors are from and how often particular pages on our Websites (cont.)

are visited. Also, to help make our Websites more responsive to the needs of our visitors, we use a standard feature of browser software, a tiny data file called a "cookie," to assign each visitor a unique, random number that resides on your computer. The cookie does not actually identify the visitor; it only identifies the computer that a visitor uses to access the Site. Unless you voluntarily identify yourself to us in some other way, we won't know who you are. You can also choose to set your Web browser to prompt you before you accept a cookie, accept cookies automatically, or reject all cookies.

Your privacy is very important to us, and COMIX35 will never share any of your Personal Information with any businesses or third parties for their own direct marketing uses.

Due to factors beyond our control we cannot fully ensure that your Personal Information will not be disclosed to third parties. For example, we may be legally obligated to disclose information to the government or third parties, or when we believe it is necessary to comply with law, to protect our interests or property, to prevent fraud or other illegal activity perpetrated through our Websites, or to prevent imminent harm to any person or group of people. This may include sharing information with other companies, lawyers, agents, or government agencies. Additionally, it is always possible that third parties may circumvent our security measures to unlawfully intercept or access your Personal Information.

Personal Information Retention

COMIX35 will retain your Personal Information as long as it is needed to achieve our purposes listed above, as well as for the amount of time necessary to meet any legal, tax, or reporting requirements.

We do not keep your Personal Information for longer than necessary and up to 10 years after your last interaction with us (e.g., making a donation, registering for an event, or purchasing materials). We may keep your data for longer than 10 years for legal or technical reasons. We may also keep it for statistical purposes. However, if we do, we will ensure that your privacy continues to be protected and only use it for these purposes.

Children's Privacy

We welcome users of all ages, including children under the age of 13, to use our Websites. Due to our status as a nonprofit organization, we are not required to comply with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA). However, we believe children, aged 13 and under, should always get permission from their parents before sending any Personal Information about themselves (such as their names, e-mail addresses, and/or phone numbers) over the Internet, to us or to anyone else. We will not knowingly allow anyone under 13 to provide us with any Personal Information. If you are under 13, please do not provide any Personal Information about yourself through our Websites.

If a child under the age of 16 in the EEA attempts to register for our newsletter, purchase products or materials, or participate in any activity requiring the submittal of Personal Information, a parent or guardian must give permission and consent for that child to provide (cont.)

information and register. Parents have the right to request at any time that Personal Information collected about their child is removed from our database.

Donor Privacy

COMIX35 receives online donations primarily through GiveDirect. We also receive donations through third-party businesses such as Paypal Giving Fund or Paypal.me, AmazonSmile, and eBay Giving Works. All sensitive consumer data is securely transmitted directly to these third parties without passing through our servers. All of these related businesses have GDPR-compliant privacy policies, which are listed at the bottom of this page.

The COMIX35 Board of Directors formally resolved in July 2008 that no Personal Information for any donor, which is on file and under the control of COMIX35, would be sold, rented or traded by COMIX35.

In the unlikely event that COMIX35 undergoes a sale or transfer of all or substantially all of its assets, the acquiring entity will be subject to this Privacy Policy in its use of your Personal Information. In addition, in the further unlikely event that COMIX35 is adjudicated bankrupt or insolvent (a) there will be no further use or disclosure of your Personal Information by COMIX35 and (b) your Personal Information will be destroyed. In addition, there will be no use or disclosure of your Personal Information by any entity that acquires assets of COMIX35 pursuant to such bankruptcy or insolvency proceedings.

Opting-out of Newsletters

Subscriptions to the COMIX35 e-mail newsletter are optional, and COMIX35 allows subscribers or other users to unsubscribe from our newsletter at any time. In each e-mail newsletter we provide instructions at the bottom of the e-mail regarding how you can easily unsubscribe from future newsletter mailings. You can also e-mail us at privacy@comix35.org to opt-out of our e-mail newsletter subscription database and ensure that you will cease receiving future e-mail newsletters from us.
