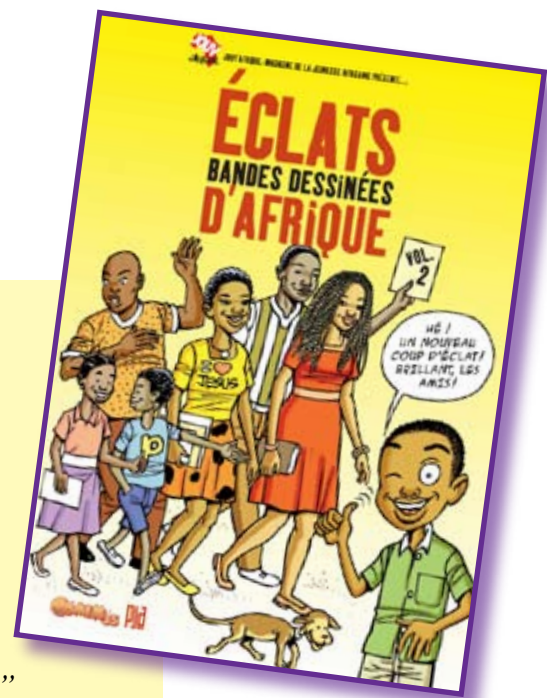


Here's what The LORD used your support to accomplish in 2013!

By God's grace, your investment in the COMIX35 ministry has continued to yield big dividends around the world! Check out these **Highlights from 2013**:

+ AFRICA: You supported the publication of two issues of *ÉCLATS: Bandes Dessinées d'Afrique* ("Bursts: Comics of Africa"). These are African **Christian comics produced by and for French-speaking Africans**. Writer/artists contributed from the Ivory Coast, Gabon, Chad, Central African Republic, and Cameroon. Our publishing partners write that our mentoring "has started [a] movement [which] has brought African Christian comic artists closer together. Please pray that these relationships will continue to grow into a strong and positive force for communicating Jesus Christ in French-speaking Africa."

+ USA: You supported **our first comics event for Native Americans** (and ministry workers who serve them) in Durango, CO, which we held in partnership with Christ for Native Youth and Western Indian Ministries!

+ EASTERN EUROPE: You supported a Christian comics seminar in Kiev, Ukraine, for **18 students to create evangelistic comics** in leaflets, brochures, newspapers, and church magazines. Students came from as far away as Kyrgystan and Uzbekistan!

+ US PRISONS: You supported production of a new tract, *Face the Music*, the personal testimony of ex-offender and prison evangelist Manny Mill of Koinonia House National Ministries. **An inmate artist adapted the story and illustrated it.** Several thousand copies have already been shared at correctional facilities in Illinois, South Dakota, Minnesota, Louisiana, and New Jersey. The Spanish version, *Paso al Frente*, could surpass that!

+ QUÉBEC, CANADA: You supported Editions Samy -- a Québécois Christian publishing team that formed after attending our April 2011 comics seminar -- in producing an **eight-page evangelistic comic tract** entitled *Le Roi de la Montagne* ("King of the Mountain") last August, just in time for distribution at the 2013 Canada Summer Games in Québec. **This is the largest multi-sport competition in the country!**
